Galway Rotary Membership Application

Types of Membership:

Individual: \$200 per year

- A single voting membership

Family: \$250 per year

- A single voting membership and an extra membership for spouse / significant other.
- Family members must reside in the same household.

Corporate Membership: \$250 per year, plus \$40 per extra member up to 4 total members.

- A single voting membership plus up to 3 additional corporate members.

Not for Profit Membership: \$250 per year, for up to 4 total members

- A single voting membership plus up to 3 additional not for profit members.
- Membership fees include Rotary International, District & Club Dues and a \$25 donation to the Rotary Foundation. It is through the foundation that we can receive grants to do larger scale projects.
- Club dues are primarily used to create fundraisers for community support activities, or purchase community items, ie: Flags to hand out at the Galway Memorial Day Parade.

The Rotary Year goes from July 1 - June 30

We offer membership "scholarships" for those who want to help the community but can not afford the full membership rate.
